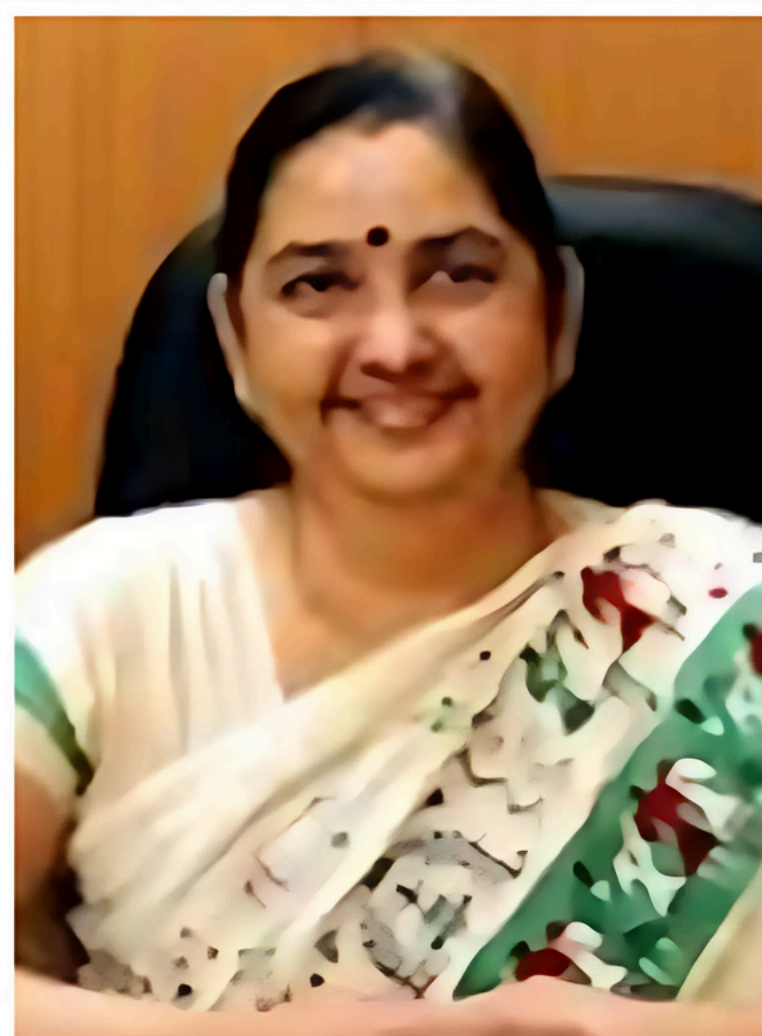

ABOUT IPSA

The Indian Political Science Association (IPSA) is the highest, the oldest and the largest academic and professional body of teachers and scholars of Political Science and Public Administration in India. This is the national association and non-profit registered organization. The aims and intellectual traditions of IPSA are- Advancement of Political Science; Scientific Study of Politics; Dissemination of Knowledge, and Rigorous Political Enquiry.

The Indian Political Science Association was established in December 1938 on the advice and invitation of Bharat Ratna Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya at Varanasi. Pandit Govind Ballabh Pant, the then Premier of United Province (presently Uttar Pradesh), was invited to preside over the inauguration of IPSA. The need to start an association had been felt for a long time and it was in May 1938 that it was actually decided. A circular was issued at the end of August 1938, inviting cooperation of scholars of Political Science for this auspicious journey. The first conference was held on 22-24 December 1938 with the singing of Vande Mataram song. Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya, the Vice Chancellor, welcomed the delegates and spoke briefly of the pressing political issues facing the country. Dr. A.S. Altekar took the delegates to Sarnath for excursion. Dr. P.N. Banerjee of Calcutta was elected as President and Sri Gurumukh Nihal Singh of Banaras was elected as Secretary and Treasurer. Dr. Beni Prasad of Allahabad and Dr. V.S. Ram of Lucknow became Vice Presidents.

In September 1939, the IPSA started publication of a quarterly journal entitled "The Indian Journal of Political Science (IJPS)". In 2009, the IPSA started publication of a bi-annual journal in Hindi entitled "Bhartiya Rajniti Vijnan Shodh Patrika". Prof. Sanjeev Kumar Sharma became the first Editor of the Hindi journal.

In its history of more than 86 years, IPSA has organised Annual Political Science Conferences regularly. Renowned political scientists of the country from all regions and institutions have held positions in IPSA Executive Committee and the Editorial Board. IPSA has held events throughout the country from Lahore (1940) to Trivandrum (1948), from Bombay (1941) to Calcutta (1950), from Waltair (1957) to Ahmedabad (1966). IPSA Conferences have been held more than once at: Mysore (3), Chennai (4), Jaipur (3), Calcutta (3), Meerut (3), Lucknow (2), Hyderabad (3), Jodhpur (2), Agra (2), Aligarh (2), Poona (2), Ujjain (2).

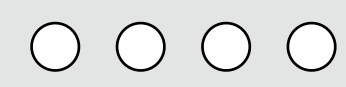

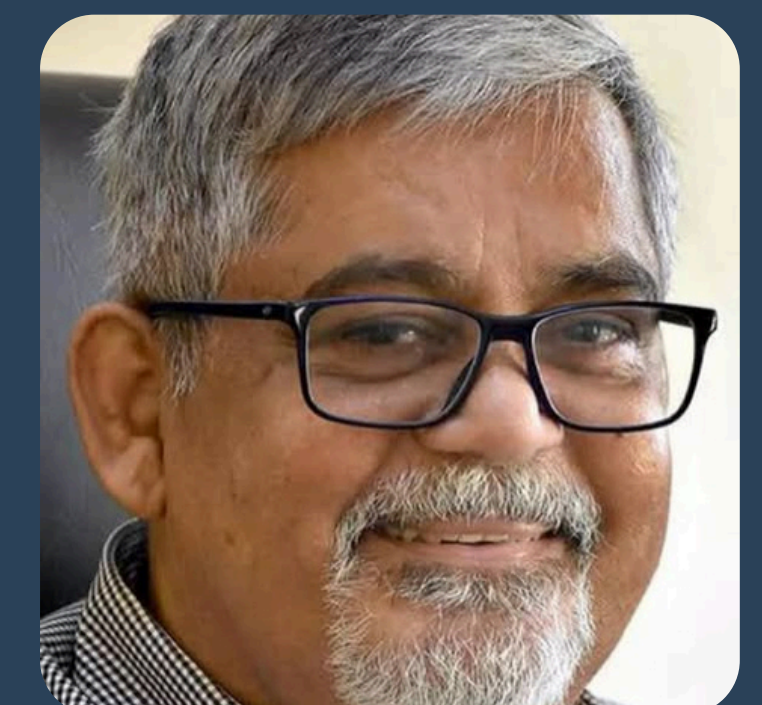

EDITORIAL POLICIES

Submission of Manuscripts

One copy of the manuscript, typed in double spacing throughout, should be sent to 'The Editor' at officeipsa@gmail.com in MS Word format only. The first page of the paper should bear only the name(s) of the author(s), designation, complete postal address, mobile/telephone number and email, title of the paper and 100 words curriculum vitae of the author(s). The second page should contain an abstract of 100 words and the title of the article, but not the author's name. Manuscripts should normally be between 4000-6000 words. Manuscripts which are not in the style of the journal will be rejected summarily. The articles are subjected to anonymous pre-review before being accepted for publication. A complimentary copy of the journal shall be supplied to the principal author.

Duplicity

Dual submissions are not accepted. Please attach to every submission a covering letter confirming that all the authors have agreed to the submission and that the article/paper is not currently being considered for publication by any other journal. Submission of an article implies that it has not been published or accepted for publication elsewhere.

References

At the end of the paper, all references should be consolidated in a single list starting on a new page. References should be placed in the text in superscript numericals. The list on the last page should include the author's name, title, publisher, place and the year of publication, page number. Authors are particularly requested to verify that each text reference appears in the list, and viceversa. Jargon should be avoided. Technical terms not widely understood should be clearly defined; and the conclusions of statistical analysis should be set out in prose, as well as being supported by quantitative information in tables and text as appropriate.
